### Cycling without age

BOBC has secured a 25000-dollar grant to be applied to the purchase of bikes. This is 7000 short of purchasing 3 bikes. This was seconded by Jeff Walsh and approved by all members. There is an Echo Press story in the works about the BOBC and the Mountaineers. This will be a great way to promote cycling without age and the club.
